Report on Industrial Visit

Industrial visit is an important pedagogy of bridging the gap between class room learning and practical application of any subject. An Industrial visit was arranged by Department of PG Studies for a batch of 50 students of I and II year M.com to Tumkur dairy and Unibic biscuit factory at Nelamangala on 8th May 2018 accompanied by two faculty Mohammed Nawaz and Mr.Banu Prakash.

The Tumkur dairy was started during 1976 by the Karnataka Dairy Development Corporation (KDDC) with the object of supporting the marketing activities of the Bangalore market. Hence, 30,000 litres capacity farm cooler was established. Subsequently, during 1981, this has been converted as 60 TLPD feeder plant.

The processing capacity of the dairy was increased to 1 lakh litres during 2005 under Perspective plan phase I. Due to the rapid increase in milk procurement, again the processing capacity of the dairy is increased to 3.25 lakh litres per day. The new packing block with increased processing capacity was inaugurated on 16-09-2013. The new flexi milk packing block was inaugurated on 06-10-20

At 11.30 am students arrived at Tukmur dairy and we were well received by the HR manager of the unit and accommodated students in the conference room for brief introduction and history of Tumkur dairy, further he gave an overview of various production lines, departments, processes, products, by products and joint products of dairy and later manager took students to various departments of the dairy and showed the complete process of converting raw material into various finished products. During the visit to different process students had queries and these were well clarified by the manager.

After a stay of two hours at the plant, the manager distributed dairy products to students as exit refreshment which was thoroughly enjoyed by students.

After having lunch we moved from tumkur to Nelamangala to visit Unibic biscuit factory.

At 3.30 we reached factory gate and after the security check the students were given hand gloves and were taken to seminar hall to brief about the introduction of the factory and also explained the rules and guidelines to be followed by everyone inside the factory. We were taken to assembly line by production manager and briefly explained the operation and production of various biscuit products and students were given clear understanding of the process right from cleaning of flour to making of biscuits to packing of the same.

We were given a send off with small evening refreshment.

At 6:30 students reached the college and provided their feedback of gaining the practical knowledge at Tumkur dairy and Unibic biscuit factory.
