Introduction

The first-year BA students were instructed by Professor Kashinatha to watch two YouTube videos on Jataka Tales, specifically the Ruru Jataka and Mahakapi Jataka tales. These stories are essential elements of the Cultural Heritage of India syllabus, offering ancient Indian moral narratives that provide timeless lessons.

Objectives of the Seminar

The objective of this activity was to engage students with traditional Indian folklore through the Ruru Jataka and Mahakapi Jataka tales. By understanding and discussing these stories, students could reflect on the values within India's cultural heritage and develop interpretive skills.

Activity Summary

Videos Assigned

Ruru Jataka Tale: This story highlights themes of compassion and selflessness, centered on a compassionate deer who saves a drowning man, only to be later betrayed.

Mahakapi Jataka Tale: This tale focuses on the importance of leadership and sacrifice, illustrated by a wise monkey king who risks his life to save his troop.

Moral Insights: Students recognized key moral teachings, such as the importance of compassion and honesty in Ruru Jataka and the value of leadership and self-sacrifice in Mahakapi Jataka.


Personal Reflections: Students related these morals to contemporary values, noting how the tales remain relevant as guides for ethical living and personal integrity.
