Saluting the National Flag:

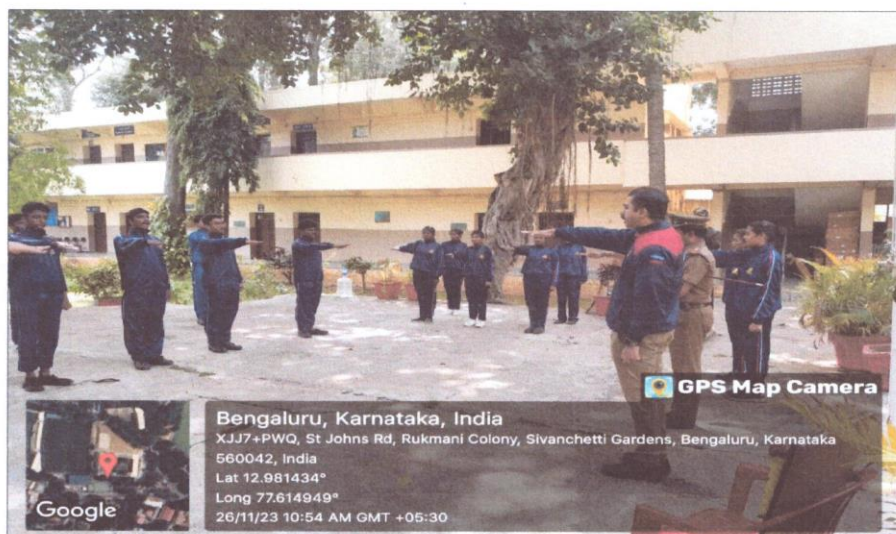
Following the oath, cadets paid tribute to the national flag by saluting it, reinforcing their respect and loyalty to the country.

What is the Concept of Voters' Pledge?

- It states- "We, the Citizens of India, having abiding faith in democracy, hereby pledge to uphold the democratic traditions of our country and the dignity of free, fair and peaceful elections, and to vote in every election fearlessly and without being influenced by considerations of religion, race, caste, community, language or any inducement."

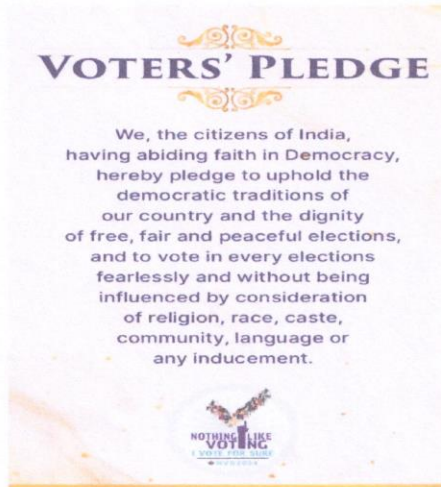
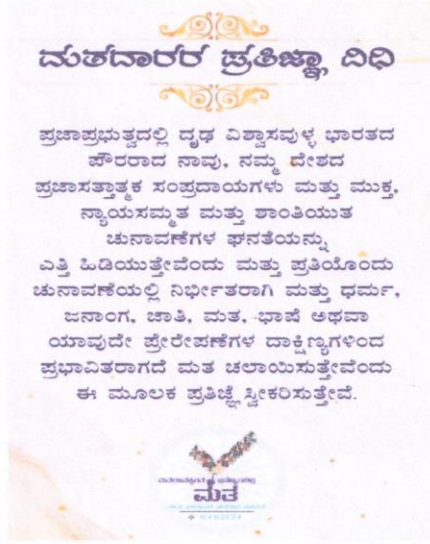
Objectives of event: The main objectives of National Voters' Day are to:

- Encourage newly eligible voters to participate in the electoral process. This is done by registering to vote and exercising their right to vote.
- Raise awareness about the importance of voting. Awareness of its role in the development of the country.

- Promote electoral participation among women, minorities & other marginalized communities.
- Recognize and felicitate outstanding performers. It can be in the field of election management and conduct.
- Promote the use of technology in the electoral process. This is to enhance transparency, accuracy, and efficiency.
- Promote ethical & informed voting. Vote buying is discouraged, along with intimidation and other malpractices.
- Strengthen the foundation of democracy in the country. This ensures a free, fair, and transparent electoral process.

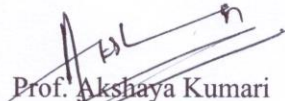

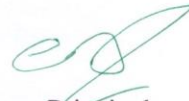
