They designed models that represented their start-up ideas, products or business concepts, allowing them to turn theoretical knowledge into tangible prototypes. This exhibition encouraged students to think critically about problem-solving, product design, and market fit.

Some of the important models with regard to entrepreneurial skill development, exhibited are:

1. Rain Water Harvesting Model
2. Smart City Layout
3. Water Management and Sanitation

The Rain Water Harvesting Model – revolved around environmental sustainability by showcasing the ways to harvest water in a city layout. It brought out their entrepreneurial thinking and planning.

Additionally, it encouraged the students to be morally responsible for practicing conservation and utilization of water in most appropriate manner and also spread awareness related.

Smart City layout- Smart City development concept dwelled on generating power from the solar, air and water technology. It explored the ideas to conserve energy through various power saving and economic methods. Also it aimed at emphasising the need of energy conservation for a more sustainable environment.



Water Management and Sanitation-

The importance of spreading awareness and educating the youth about the latest technology for conserving water was the main objective of this model.

It emphasised on how an entrepreneur would find ways to provide employment through the various sanitation industry set up. Additionally, the model depicted the importance of keeping the city clean and managing and conserving water bodies.

In conclusion, the event of Epiphany – Model Exhibition provided a platform for the Students to present their ideas to faculty, mentors and peers, receiving constructive feedback to refine their concepts.

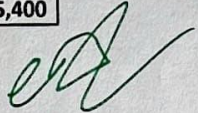

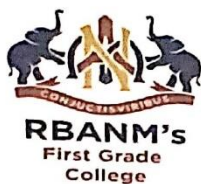

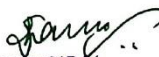
