

- This initiative also boosted confidence, leadership skills, and communication abilities.




Moreover, the food stalls were especially effective in attracting foot traffic, increasing visibility for young entrepreneurs.


The process strengthened their ability to pitch ideas, engage audiences, and address challenges—skills crucial for entrepreneurship.

The Rain Water Harvesting Model – revolved around environmental sustainability by showcasing the ways to harvest water in a city layout. It brought out their entrepreneurial thinking and planning.
