Participant: Cadet Shireesha D

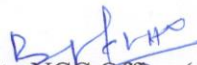

Competitions: Friendly competitions were organized to test the skills and knowledge acquired during the camp, promoting healthy competition among cadets.

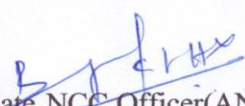
Outcome
