

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) plays a key role in shaping students into disciplined, responsible, and patriotic individuals.

Our institution hosts two NCC wings to contributing to the holistic development of students namely the Army Wing, celebrated its Silver Jubilee and the Navy Wing has been established in 2016 completing seven years.
